

# Generic Installation Instructions for ArcGIS 9.3

Note: Click = Left Mouse Click



## Minimum system requirements

Your computer is required to meet minimum system requirements in order to install ArcGIS 9.3.

## Minimum System Requirements to install ArcGIS 9.3

<b>Processor</b>	Pentium® 1 GHz minimum
<b>Operating system</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Microsoft Windows 2000 Professional with Service Pack 3 or higher</li> <li>• Microsoft Windows Server 2003</li> <li>• Microsoft XP Home Edition with Service Pack 1 or higher</li> <li>• Microsoft XP Professional Edition with Service Pack 1 or higher</li> </ul> <p>(hereafter collectively referred to as Microsoft Windows)</p>
<b>Internet Explorer</b>	You must obtain and install the appropriate language version of Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher prior to installing ArcGIS Desktop. See Note below.
<b>Windows Installer</b>	3.1
<b>RAM</b>	512 MB minimum
<b>Installation Drive</b>	A complete installation of ArcGIS Desktop and extensions requires 1433 MB NTFS disk space.
<b>System Drive</b>	Up to 50 MB Typically C: where windows\system32 is located

### Note:

If your computer does not include Internet Explorer Version 6.0 or higher, the ArcGIS Desktop setup will notify you of the missing requirement and exit. You must obtain and install Internet Explorer, then run the ArcGIS Desktop setup again.

## **NOTE:**

User must have Administrative Rights to the computer in order to install ArcGIS 9.3. Check with your System Administrator if you are unsure of your permission settings.

# Step 1



Previous versions of ArcGIS must be removed before ArcGIS 9.3 can be installed. All of the following programs, if they are on your computer, must be uninstalled.

- ArcGIS ArcInfo Workstation
- ArcGIS Desktop
- ArcGIS Developer Kit
- ArcGIS Tutorial Data
- Crystal Reports for ESRI
- Python 2.1
- Python 2.1 combined Win 32 extensions

To uninstall programs:

From the operating system Start menu click:  
**Start > Settings > Control Panel**

Double-click **Add or Remove Programs**






In the *Add or Remove Programs* window click on the name of the program you want to uninstall.

- Click **Remove**.
- Click **Yes** to the question asking if you are sure you want to remove the program.
- Message boxes will display while the uninstall takes place.
- When the uninstall is complete the message boxes will disappear.

Continue with these instructions until all of the programs from the previous page have been removed.

- The entire uninstall process may take up to ½ hour.

***When all of the programs have been removed Restart your computer.***



## Step 2

Exit all Windows programs before starting the ArcGIS 9.3 Installation process!

## Step 3

Insert the **ArcGIS 9 – ArcGIS Desktop 9.3** DVD into your computer.

This will bring up the installation options window.


- Click on **ArcGIS Desktop**

**Note:** If installation window does not Display then browse to your DVD drive And double click on **ESRI.exe**





- Click **Next**





## In the *License Agreement* window

- Click **Next**




In the *License Manager* window

- Click **Next**




In the *Select the default software product...* window

- Click **Next**




### In the *Select Installation Type* window

### In the *Destination Folder* window


- The user can accept the default location

- Click **Next**





In the *ArcGIS Desktop has been successfully installed* window


- Click **Finish**

Otherwise:


In the *installation options* window

- Click **ArcGIS Desktop Tutorial Data**




## In *Welcome to ArcGIS Tutorial Data Setup* program

- Click **Next**




## In the *License Agreement* window

- Click **Next**




In the *Select Installation Type* window







## Step 6

Close the ArcGIS Desktop installation options box by clicking the red **X** in the upper right corner.



**Remove** the **ArcGIS 9 – ArcGIS Desktop 9.3** DVD from your computer.

## Step 7


This step will provide instructions on how to install ArcInfo Workstation. **It is optional.**

Otherwise:


Insert the **ArcGIS 9 – ArcInfo Workstation 9.3** DVD into your computer.

**Note:** This message box may display on the screen...in a few moments it will disappear.




**Note:** The below message box may display on the screen...if it does then **Click OK**.

If this message box does not display, then manually open Windows Explorer to browse the DVD.




In the Windows Explorer window

- Double-click the **windows** folder




In the Windows Explorer window

- Double-click **Setup.exe** to initiate the installation process




### In *Installation Type* window

- Click **Next**





- Click **Next**




